

Conservation and Research Internship – Volunteer Position

Join the team at the Conservation Ecology Centre (CEC) on an internship - Volunteer Interns are needed to assist the CEC with its conservation and research program, including on ground action, ecological research, community engagement and animal husbandry. During an internship at the CEC you will gain experience in:

- Conservation activities, including forest restoration and revegetation, monitoring and general land management activities.
- Projects include investigations into the decline of habitat, threats from invasive species and studying the endangered species of the Otways, including the Eastern Ground Parrot, Broad-Toothed Rat and the Smoky Mouse.
- Coordinating volunteers, engaging the community and managing a non-profit organisation.
- Day to day husbandry of the CEC's display animals

This position provides great opportunities for gaining experience in wildlife handling, research project design, data collection and analysis, community engagement and habitat conservation.

Key Selection Criteria:

- 1) Current Drivers Licence (accepted in Australia, manual preferred)
- 2) Completed a degree in ecology, biology, wildlife conservation, zoology, conservation biology, land management, NRM or similar (required).
- 3) Experience collecting, collating and analysing ecological data (preferred).
- 4) The ability to work in remote field locations (experience preferred).
- 5) Running practical knowledge and experience of land management and conservation techniques (preferred).
